IV. Rules:

New EITF rules will be applied adjusted by this info pack. Approved protection only by [List](#). Mouth guard is compulsory.

Year of birth (not the exact date!!) is the key for distribution to age groups. Organizer has the right to unite categories if there are low number of competitors.

V. Number of competitors:

Number of competitors for each tkd club is not regulated. Maximum of **five** competitors from each club is allowed for power breaking and special techniques. Qualification technique will be chosen by competitor himself in both disciplines (wirok, t-ki).

VI. Protest:

Protest against umpire's decision must be done with valid procedure with payment **500 CZK**.

VII. Umpires:

Each club has to bring :

1 qualified umpire if have less than 15 competitors

2 qualified umpires if have 15 or more competitors

Referees should be at minimum I. degree holder and have to be dressed by official EITF/ITF rules. Clubs without any or with missing referees must pay a fine of 700 CZK / referee.

Umpires have breakfast and lunch on Saturday.

VII. Trophies:

Medals will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd place in every category. Trophies will be given to most successful competitors and club.
